Kid's Short Course

The 5K and 1 Mile routes include the Marquette Pioneer Trail (unpaved) and Marquette city streets (paved). The Kid's Short Course is for children ages 8 and under only and is run on Washington Street. Small children are invited to participate and this course is the length of two city blocks. Parents can run with their children for free to encourage or help their child in the Kid's Short Course. All events start at 8:00 a.m.

Race Packet Pick-up/Race Day Registration

All those pre-registered can pick up race packets on the day of the race, starting at 7:00 a.m. in front of the Kansas Motorcycle Museum, which is at the corner of Washington (Main) and 3rd Streets. Those not pre-registered can register at the Kansas Motorcycle Museum from 7:00-7:30 a.m. on race day.

Awards

5K awards for the top three in each age group division and the top male and female finishers will be presented at 9:00 a.m. There are no awards for 1 Mile Run/Walk participants. All Kid's Short Course runners will get a small medal at the finish line immediately following their race. There will also be door prizes drawn during the awards ceremony. Participants must be present at the award ceremony to claim awards and the door prize.

Course Records

The Rodeo Run 5K race record holders are Daniel Craig of Gypsum with a time of 17:03 and Jill Hedberg of Sioux Falls, South Dakota with a time of 22:59. Both records were set at the 2015 Rodeo Run.
