  - 3. QUALIFICATIONS FOR ENTRY TO COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIP INDIVIDUAL:** Birth or 9 months continuous bona fide residence in the county of Nottinghamshire prior to the date of the race. Any athlete who competed in a County Championship or represented a county may not compete in another County Championship in the same calendar year.   - 4. QUALIFICATIONS FOR ENTRY TO COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM:** Runners must be first claim membership to an EA affiliated club that has registered with EA for road running, is a member of the EA registration scheme and is based in Nottinghamshire. Club vests must be worn.
